

Farmers' Market Rules

1. The market will be in operation from May - August on the following days and times (hours may be adjusted or extended by Scott County Farmer's Market & Crafter's Association).
Saturdays 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.
2. All Vendors must display a sign indicating their name, address and phone number.
3. All Vendors are required to be a Farmers' Market member. Seasonal dues are \$30.00, annual memberships are \$50.00 and daily rate is \$10.00.
4. Vendors are required to dress appropriately and to consider seasonal weather, personal safety and necessity.
5. Vendors may sell from the back of pick-up trucks or trailers in designated areas only.
6. No overnight parking is allowed.
7. The following items may be offered for sale at the market: fruits, vegetables, farm-fresh eggs, plants, herbs, flowers, honey, farm products, baked goods and crafts. No fruit or vegetable products (sold for consumption) can be displayed directly on the ground/concrete. All vendors must clearly label the price of all products.
8. Sales tax is the responsibility of each vendor.
9. Live animals may be advertised at an individual's inside booth but live animals are not permitted inside the building.
10. Sales must be made in an orderly and business-like manner. Shouting, hawking and other loud and objectionable tactics of solicitation are not allowed. No profanity or loud radios.
11. Leashed and well-behaved pets are allowed inside the building. Please do not leave pets unattended or allow them to wander.
12. Vendor families are welcome. Any minors accompanying vendors or assisting in sales must follow all the Market's rules. It is the vendors responsibility to supervise all minors and their behavior. Please do not leave children unattended.
13. No smoking inside the building or in front of the entry doors.
14. Booths must be swept and cleaned before the vendor departs the market each day. Your signs, displays and shelving must be removed at the end of the day.
15. Vendors may be required to supply their own tables and chairs.
16. All vendors assume all responsibility for any losses of property or money from the market site.
17. Vendor booths should never be left unattended.
18. All rules are in effect if the Farmer's Market utilizes a bigger venue for our sponsored bazars.
19. As the Market grows and vendor numbers increase and decrease through the season it may be necessary to limit each individual vendor's overall space. That will fall to the discretion of the Board and Market manager.
20. Any vendor found not to be in compliance with any of the above guidelines will:

*Receive a warning from the Scott County Farmer's Market and Crafter's Association.

*Removal of Farmers' Market membership. No refund for membership fees will be given.
